Lost on the Moon!

4th Grade Space Remote Learning Lesson, Tuesday, May 5

This is your last TAG lesson for the year. Next week you can work on make-up work.

Your spaceship has just crash-landed on the light side of the moon. You were scheduled to rendezvous with a mother ship 200 km away on the surface of the moon, but the rough landing has ruined your ship and destroyed all equipment on board, except for the 15 items listed below.

Your crew's survival depends on reaching the mother ship, so you must choose the most critical items for the 200 km trip. Your task is to rank the 15 items in terms of their importance for survival. Do this first by yourself, without any input from anyone else. Place 1 by the most important item, 2 by the second most important, and so on through 15, the least important. Write an explanation as to why you gave the rankings you did.

Then, rank the items a second time. This time, consult your family! Show them your rankings and explanations, and then rank them again with your family. Your family will talk, and come to a consensus (agreement). Write explanations as to why your family gave the rankings they did. If your entire family cannot do it at the same time, do it with whoever is home with you. You will probably need some information about the moon, so go HERE, to learn more about the conditions there. You can also watch THIS VIDEO for even more information about the moon. And here's a great answer to the question, "What would it be like to live on the moon?"
