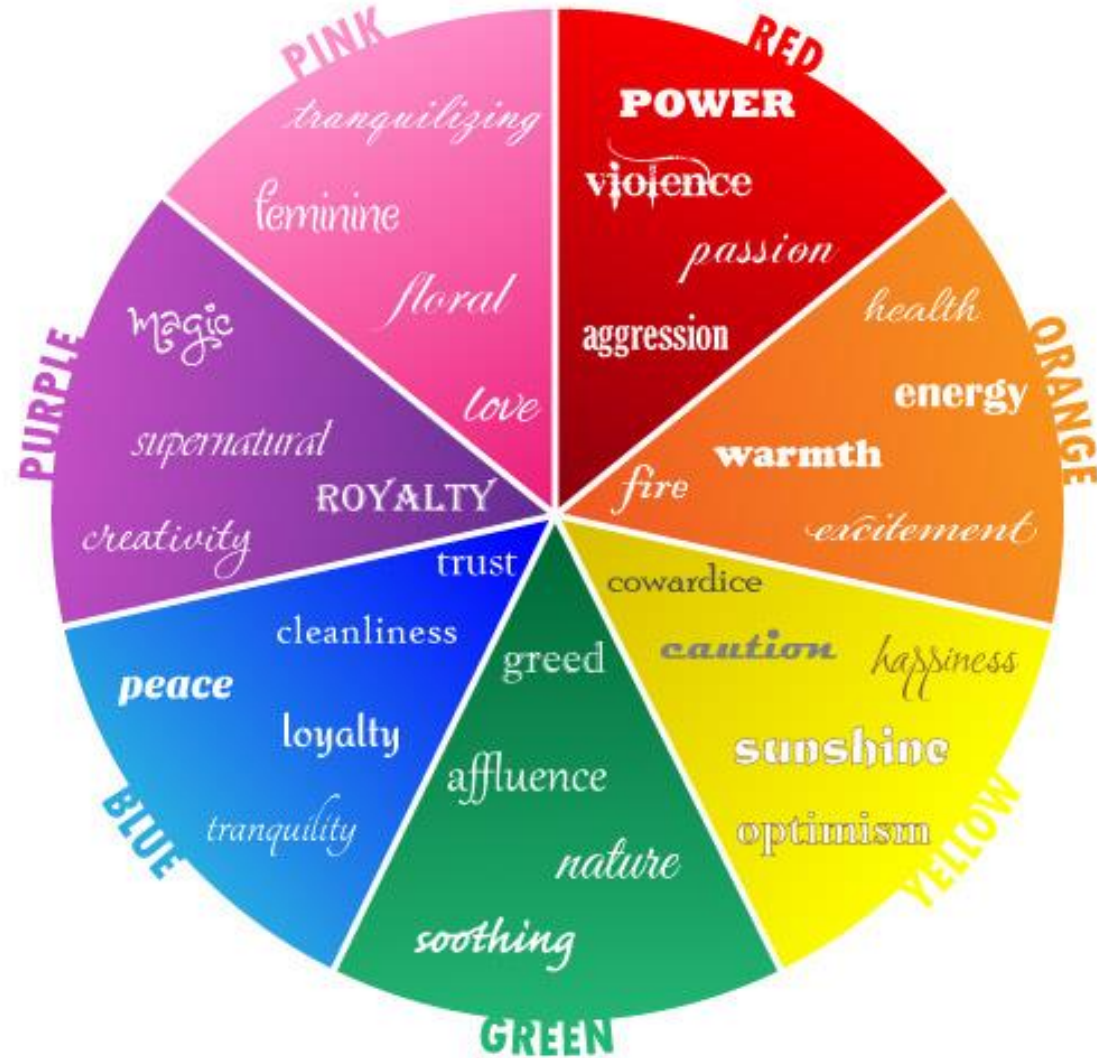


Sketch an image that you think best represents the essence of that idea.




This routine asks learners to identify and distill the essence of ideas -
